

ARTICLE X – RECORDER

- Section 1. There shall be a Recorder who shall be employed by the Federation. The Administrative Officers shall propose to the Executive Board a qualified individual for ratification. Salary and other considerations shall be determined by the Administrative Officers with the consent of the Executive Board. In the case of an interim vacancy in this position, the Administrative Officers shall act to fill the position pending the approval of the Executive Board at its next meeting.
- Section 2. The Recorder shall have charge of all registers and records pertaining to the Stud Book and Foundation Record. These registers and records shall remain the property of the Federation.
- Section 3. The Recorder, under the rules determined by the Federation, shall record applications for registration and issue certificates in acknowledgement thereof, record and confirm championships, grand championships, master grand championships, and perform such other duties as may be required by the Federation and specified in the Standing Rules for the position. The CFF Recorder's office will notify within 30 days the owner of a CFF-registered cat when it is eligible for the title of Grand Champion and Master Grand Champion.
