

Old Style Siamese

Head	20	The shape of the Old Style Siamese head is the most important feature of the cat. Old Style Siamese breeders refer to these cats as Applehead style, therefore the shape of the head is that of an apple, round preferred but oval is acceptable, with no evidence of a wedge shaped head.
Muzzle	13	The muzzle enhances the roundness of the head. The length and width of the muzzle is wider than long, neither pointy or blunt.
Nose	5	In profile, the nose has a gentle dip, located at eye level.
Ears	5	The ears are medium in size, broad at the base with rounded tips. They are set as much on the top of the head as on the side and are tilted forward.
Eyes	5	The top eyelid is slightly slanted. The bottom eyelid is slightly rounded. Eye placement should be an eye width apart.
Eye Color	12	The eye color is blue with depth, brilliance and clarity preferred.
Neck	8	The neck is in proportion to the head and the body.
Body	13	The body is medium to large in size with muscular development, Neither cobby or refined.
Legs	7	The legs are well-muscled and medium in length, with hind legs slightly longer than the front.
Paws	2	The paws are more round than oval and are medium in size.
Tail	5	The tail is medium in length, and not past the shoulder when drawn against the side of the body. Where the tail meets the body it is thick, tapering to the end of the tail. A whippy tail is a fault.
Coat/Coat Color	5	The coat is short and soft in texture. It is somewhat close lying, but does not snap back into place when stroked. The coat color of the body should be even and in good contrast with the points. Depending on the point color of the cat, the color on the body should be either cream or ivory. The cat's points should be rich and deep in color with all points matching. Allowance to be given to kittens whose coat is still maturing, and to mature adult cats that have considerable body darkening of color.
Penalize		Ticking in the points (except in aging older cats).

Withhold

Any eye color other than blue; improper color of nose or paw pads; wedge-shaped head, a straight profile, a long, thin or tubular body; long and/or thin legs, neck or tail.
