

APPENDIX TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP BREED STANDARDS

NOTE: The fact that a color is described in the Appendix should not be construed to imply that it is recognized for championship competition in any particular breed or breeds; the reader is referred to Article VI, Section 2 of the CFF Show Rules for the official listing of colors recognized for championship in each breed. For questions concerning eyecolor, confirmation or specific characteristics, refer to the individual breed standards.

COLOR DESCRIPTIONS

SOLID COLORS

- BLACK** Lustrous jet black. Eye color: deep orange or copper. **Nose leather:** black. **Paw pads:** black to charcoal. Allowance to be made in kittens and young adults for smoky undercoat.
- BLUE** Blue. Lighter shade preferred. Eye color: deep orange or copper. **Nose leather & paw pads:** blue to mauve.
- CHESTNUT** Rich, chestnut brown, sound throughout. **Nose leather & paw pads:** cinnamon.
- CINNAMON** A light reddish-brown, distinctly lighter and warmer than chestnut, sound and even throughout. **Nose leather and paw pads:** pinkish tan
- CREAM** Cream. Lighter shades preferred. Eye color: deep orange or copper. **Nose leather & paw pads:** cream to pink.
- EBONY** Lustrous jet black, sound to the roots. **Nose leather & paw pads:** black.
- FAWN** Taupe with distinct pale cocoa overtones, sound and even throughout. **Nose leather & paw pads:** a light dusty rose without blue or lavender tones.
- LAVENDER** Frost-gray with a pinkish tone, sound and even throughout. **Nose leather and paw pads:** lavender pink.
- RED** Deep, rich, clear, brilliant red. Minimal shading and markings allowed on head and legs. Eye color: deep orange or copper. **Nose leather and paw pads:** pink to brick red.
- WHITE** Pure glistening white. Eye color: deep blue, copper, or odd-eyed. Odd-eyed whites shall have one blue eye and one copper eye of equal color depth, except for the Oriental Shorthair which shall have one vivid green eye and one vivid blue eye. In Oriental Shorthairs vivid green is acceptable where orange or copper is called for. **Nose leather and paw pads:** pink. Dark spot on head allowed until maturity.
