

STANDING RULE #12 -- ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS

1. The Administrative Officers shall constitute an Appeal Board. Upon appeal of a member club from the decision of the Judging Coordinator or upon appeal by an individual from a decision of the Recorder, the Appeal Board shall consult and rule on the appeal within ten (10) days.
2. The Administrative Officers shall have standing authority to initiate investigations, suspend, or otherwise take appropriate action for cause against any officer, office, or committee of the Federation, whether elected or appointed. Any actions taken by the Administrative Officers must be agreed to by two-thirds (2/3) of the Administrative Officers.
3. The Administrative Officers shall appoint, biennially in odd-numbered years, a Standing Committee to be called the Financial Committee, composed of seven (7) members (one of whom shall be the Treasurer, who shall not be Chairman).
4. The Administrative Officers shall propose to the Executive Board a qualified individual as Recorder for ratification. In the case of an interim vacancy in this position, the Administrative Officers shall act to fill the position pending the approval of the Executive Board at its next meeting.
