

STANDING RULE #5 -- OFFICE OF THE JUDGING COORDINATOR

Duties:

1. To keep up-to--files on all CFF judges and trainees, and guest judges from other associations.
2. To grant sanctions and approve judging panels for shows held under the rules of the Federation.
3. To monitor the Judges' Training Program and present to the Executive Board, at the appropriate time, the names of those applicants who will be tested for admission into the program. This does not apply to those eligible for advancement to All-breed status. (See Standing Rule 7, Part 6, second paragraph.) The resume of all candidates for approved All-breed status shall be sent to all members.
4. To administer distribution and scoring of Qualifying examination and Refresher Questionnaire for all judges.
5. To compile a list of all eligible CFF judges and trainees and submit a current version of that list for publication in the Newsletter. This list is to include a separate section containing the names of potential guest judges from other associations with whom CFF has reciprocal agreements who have satisfied the requirements in CFF for the current show season.
6. To maintain the show schedule and keep it up to date.
7. To design and procure forms for show sanctions, approval of judges, and such other forms as are needed for the proper execution of the office.
8. To supply each CFF judge and trainee with a copy of the current Show Rules and Standards.
9. The Judging Coordinator must notify all clubs which have existing contracts with a resigning judge for a judging assignment on or after the effective date of the resignation, that the contract has been voided, and a replacement judge must be chosen by the club.
10. The Judging Coordinator shall not be a judge. In the event that a judge accepts the nomination for this office, his license to judge shall be suspended and his name removed from the list of those eligible to judge in this or other similar organizations until such time as he has completed his term in office, at which time his name shall be returned to the Judging list and his license restored. He may complete assignments contracted prior to nomination.
